



## Statement on H.R. 4173 "Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act", Section 1502 "Conflict Minerals"

Bahr Modultechnik GmbH is very closely watching the US efforts to ban and monitor the exploitation of and trade in minerals originating from the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) or its adjoining countries. This applies equally to the Dodd-Frank implementation regulations adopted in August 2012.

As a German company, Bahr Modultechnik GmbH does not directly fall within the scope of these regulations. Nevertheless, we pay close attention to the German, European and international developments regarding ethical, social and environmental standards.

Therefore, based on the information available to us, we are confident that the raw materials used in the products delivered by us do not contain any "conflict minerals" within the meaning of the above mentioned law, i.e. tin, tungsten, tantalum or gold from the DRC or its adjoining countries. Should we become aware of any information to the contrary, we will notify you immediately.
